

‘Something out of Nothing’ from Sue Ostheimer



I made "mocha muffins" using Avocado stems. Pluck the little stem off, let dry for a few days, sand or trim the dark woody end (not the bumpy part that was in the avocado) to make it flat for the muffin bottom. Paint satin varnish over the whole "muffin", let dry - done!. (The varnish should help to turn it golden brown on the bumpy top.) You can also paint the top white, brown, pink, etc. to make frosting. add seed bead "cherry" on top.
