“I made a 1/4” scene in a German wine glass. As I was making several for a Christmas gift exchange, I had to find the most efficient and least costly way to do this. The arbor, in large part, was made from plastic mesh for hibachi chef hats. It came in a roll and had to be ironed flat between aluminum foil. The table was made from 20mm silicone adhesive furniture bumpers and push pins. The floor covering was the label from a bottle of German wine. Cheese was made from fun foam. Bread was made from Crayola Magic modeling compound. Everything else was standard miniature supplies.”
