Red Hat Tea Party Hat



The hat pattern is intended to be printed onto 8.5 x 11 cardstock but the hat can be made in any type of Card Stock, or can be made of poster board and painted, or can be made of poster board and covered with fabric. It is very simple to make the brim larger or the hat body shorter. It is entirely up to you

Just decorate or embellish your hat with whatever suits your fancy, the more the better. I used ribbon and net (glitter Tulle) and a dollar store flower.

Print and cut out the pattern. The finished hat will be roughly 6 inches tall. You can size it up or down, however you like. Mine will be attached to a headband to make it easy to wear or you can attach a comb or an elastic band.

Trace the pattern onto your card stock and cut it out. Cut out the inside circle on the brim. Roll hat body into a tube and glue the seam. Glue the Small end of the hat body centered over the inside circle of the brim. Let the glue dry. Use scissors to clip the inner circle excess as shown in the diagram. Fold the flaps up into the hat and glue.

Use the scrap piece of cardstock to glue to the top of the hat body. Now it is ready to decorate or embellish.
