New Years Eve Party Hats Cat Wingler



Tools and supplies needed:

Hat printie printed on medium weight card stock Small, sharp, scissors Tweezers Toothpicks or other precise glue spreader Paint brush Tacky glue Gloss Mod Podge or equivalent Black paint Gold paint Small amounts of black and gold glitter (optional)

In general:

Cut out the parts for all three types of hat.

Paint the backs and edges of the black parts black

Paint the gold parts gold.

Ladies Tiara

Gently curve the black layer and set aside for a minute Gently gurney the white layer and set aside. Glue the fan behind the white layer. Glue the white layer and the fan to the black layer. Use your tweezers to curl the fingers of the fan. Glue the ends together to corn a circle. Set aside to dry

Fancy Party Hat

Repeat the instructions for the ladies tiara but do not close the circle.

Make the cone. Let the glue on the cone dry.

Line up the layered parts with the bottom of the cone and glue in place.

Clip and fold up the back edge of the brim.

Gently curve the brim over your finger, put glue on the front of the cone and glue the brim to the cone.

Use your tweezers to curl the fingers of the fan.

Set aside to dry.

Top Hat

Gently curve the hat body with your fingers and match and glue the edges.

Glue the hat body over the circle cut out of the hat brim.

The hat top is slightly larger that the top of the hat body to make it easier to glue in place. Put glue on the top edge of the hat body, place the top over the glue and press GENTLY into the glue. When the glue dries, trim away the excess.

Glue the fan to the back of the hat band.

Glue on the hat band with the numbers in front.

Use your fingers to gently curve the fan fingers.

Glue the clock face to the top.

Finishing the hats.

Touch up any edges that need it.

Paint the black and white hat parts with gloss Mod Podge.

Paint the clock face with gloss Mod Podge.

Set the hats aside to dry completely.


You may decorate the hats any way you please! I used glitter but small jewels might look good too.

Add the glitter. Use a small brush or toothpick to place the glue precisely where you want it. Be sure to let one color of glitter dry completely before you add the other color.


I did 2 or 3 layers of glue and glitter to the diamonds in the white layer to make it stand out and give it a little dimension.
