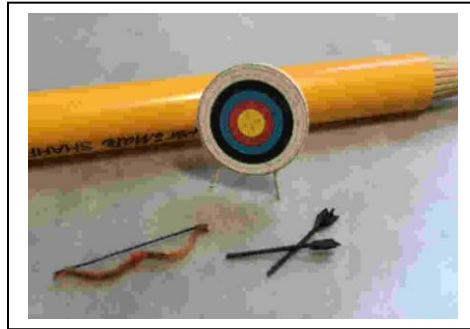


Quarter Scale Archery Set

For Camp Makamini – from Cat Wingler

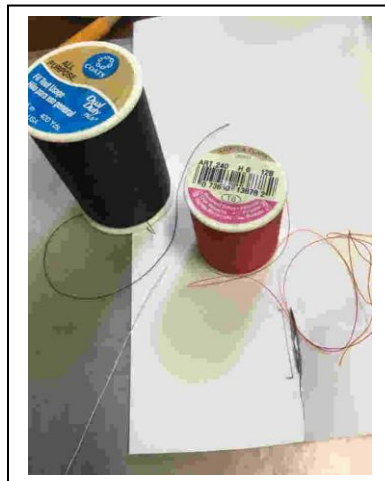


Needed:

Scrap of card stock
Red thread
Black thread
Small piece of very fine wire

Black paint
Brown paint
Red paint

Tacky glue
Fine tipped paper scissors



Instructions

The Bow

Fold a small piece of card stock in half and glue the halves together.
Paint both sides light brown

Cut a strip of the card stock a little less than 1/16 wide

Cut the strip to 7/8 long.

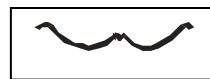
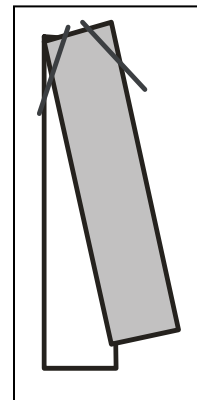
Fold it in half

Cut tiny notches on either side of the notched half

Wrap the notched section with Red thread and glue in place

Use scissors to gently taper the ends to a point.

Gently curve the paper strip to fit the shape of a recurve bow

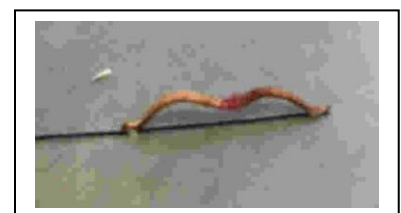


Stiffen a piece of black thread with glue and set the bow shape on top of the stiffened thread

Trim the extra thread away

Touch the red thread with red paint to make it stand out better

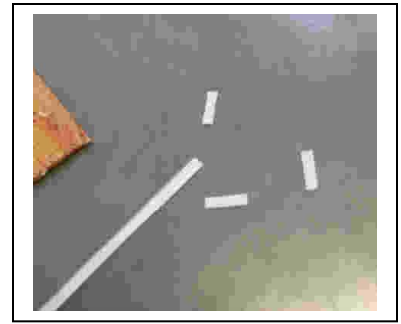
Set the finished bow aside to totally dry.



The Arrows

The arrows are just pieces of wire cut into ½” pieces. Target arrows don't have the barbed arrow shape tip so just paint the tip silver to represent the target tip.

The Feathers, (fletching) are tiny pieces of scrap card stock.



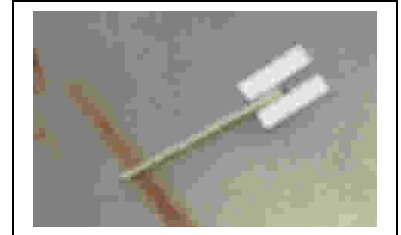
I cut a little strip and then cut it onto small chunks. 3 small pieces per arrow.

Glue one small piece to each side of the end of the wire.

When the glue is dry, use scissors to trim the feather to shape.

Glue the third “feather” on the end to stick up. Trim to shape when dry.

Paint the arrow Black.



The target and tripod

Fold a 1” piece of wire in half into a V shape

Glue another ½” piece of wire into the V to make a tripod.

Let the glue dry.

Mount the target onto a scrap of card stock and cut it out

Glue the target to the tripod.

Trim and/or bend the legs so it sits properly.
