## First Project I Taught at a Miniature Shop

## **Cinnamon Buns**

- Model Magic Air Dry Clay by Crayola White
- Acrylic Paints Raw Sienna, Dark Brown, White
- Double Stick Tape on Index Card
- Small Soft Paint Brush
- Toothpick
- Tacky Glue
- One Inch Paper Doily or Plate

## Instructions

- 1. Remove small amount of clay from package and reseal package tightly.
- 2. Roll 1/8 inch snake about 2 inches long and flatten slightly with fingers.
- 3. Curl clay snake into a tight spiral about 3/8 inch in diameter, trim excess and set aside to dry.
- 4. Repeat steps 1, 2, and 3 five more times.
- 5. Let dry overnight.
- 6. Lay out enough strips of double stick tape on an Index Card to hold all six "Buns."
- 7. Paint with several thin washes of raw sienna acrylic paint until buns look real. Let dry.
- 8. Add wash of dark brown acrylic into spiral crease for Cinnamon effect. Let dry.
- 9. Drizzle very small amount of white acrylic paint over the top of each bun to look like frosting. Let dry.
- 10. Remove buns from tape and carefully paint the bottom of each cinnamon bun with raw sienna acrylic paint. Let dry.
- 11. Glue cinnamon buns to doily or plate. You should have more than enough. Save the best looking for the top of the pile.
