

KLEENEX BOXES

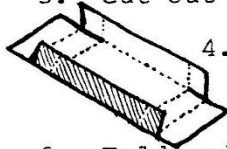
This is my first Roundtable – taught in 1979 at  
a Region N-2 Houseparty.

Materials needed:  
card stock  
printed paper  
Kleenex  
X-acto knife  
Tacky glue  
glue stick  
scissors

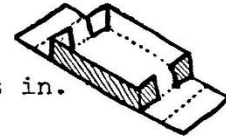
1. Cut sheet in half, separating top and bottom. With the glue stick, glue the colored paper to non-printed side of TOP pattern, set aside to dry.

2. Starting with the bottom of the box, score along the dotted lines with the dull side of the X-acto knife. Do not cut the cardboard.

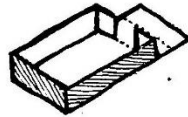
3. Cut out the bottom of the box on the solid lines.



4. Fold sides in and flatten.



5. Fold end tabs in.



6. Fold end pieces over to the inside of the box and glue in place.

7. Using the X-acto knife, cut out the hole in the top of the box. Assemble top in the same manner as the bottom, first by scoring, cutting out and then glueing.

8. Cut Kleenex on fold 3/4" long and 1/2" wide. (cut 6) Separate Kleenex layers thus giving you twelve pieces of Kleenex. Interlock Kleenex alternating fold on left and right sides so that the top of the first Kleenex is on the fold of the second. Continue doing so until all Kleenex is used.

9. Place the Kleenex in the box and lift the first Kleenex out. When you pull that piece out of the box another pops up....and another.....and another....
