## NAME Dollhouse for your Dollhouse



This project was developed by Gaye Brown many years ago as a fundraiser for NAME. On the 30th anniversary for NAME and in honor of Dollhouse month in October, this project is shared with our membership. Enjoy.

- 1. Cut out pieces from wood or tag. For the 1" version, all pieces are cut from 1/16" material except the base which is 3/16" thick and the chimneys which are 1/8" square.
- 2. Cut out paper parts. Glue large green square on the base top. Remove excess paper with X-Acto.
- 3. Center and glue NAME logo strip on the long front of the base. Wrap remaining strip around the base. Remove excess.
- 4. Glue front and sides around the first floor as shown.

- 5. Glue second floor 7/8" above the first floor.
- 6. Glue decorative exterior papers on the walls.
- 7. Center and glue roof pieces on house. Fold and glue green roofing paper on the top.
- 8. Angle cut chimney wood. Wrap brick paper on top, trim excess paper, and glue on roof.
- 9. Assemble paper dormer. Center and glue on the house.

This house can be reduced 50% for 1/2" scale and reduced again 50% for 1/4" scale. Reduce wood or tag accordingly, using card stock for 1/4" version.
