NAME Earrings & Pin

MATERIALS

- Craft glue
- Eye pins or brass #28 wire,
- Earring hangers and pin back

NAME Earrings

For each Earring you will need 2 small and 2 large NAME Logos. Cut out all 8 pattern pieces the smaller size is glued back to back with the eye pin in between centered. You can make eye pins from two 1" pieces of brass wire and a circle pliers for each earring.



After cutting out the logo and

gluing the smaller ones together allow them to dry completely. Then coat both sides with Mod Podge. Let dry again and then match the edges at the bottom small to large and glue one side of the large logo to the smaller one. When dry align the other side and glue it matching edges tightly.

The smaller shape inside will give body to the earrings. I like a gloss finish but you can use the matte also.


NAME Pin

For the Pin you will need 3 copies of the larger logo.

Glue two back to back as for the earring. Cut the window section from the third copy and score the window shape on the back side. With tweezers bend a small thin lip to add glue to and

place over the windows on the front. This will make the windows raised from the door for a 3D look. Use several coats of sealer and add pin back.

Pattern can be enlarged or reduced to your liking. Print out after you are happy with the size of the pattern.
