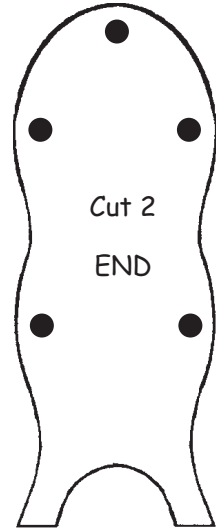


1" Scale Quilt Rack

1. Cut ends from pattern, using two pieces of 1/8" wood fastened together with double stick tape. Sand thoroughly while still taped together.
2. Drill five 1/8" holes as indicated on pattern while still taped together. Fine sand.
3. Cut five lengths of 1/8" dowel - 2-3/4" long. Glue into ends making sure ends of dowels are flush with outside of quilt rack.
4. Apply desired finish.

MATERIALS:

- 1/8" Hardwood
- 1/8" Dowels

TOOLS:

- Saw
- Drill and 1/8" bit
- Double stick tape
- Elmer's carpenters glue
- 50 and 100 Grit sandpaper
- Stain or paint and sealer
