

MATERIALS: • 1/8" Hardwood

- · 1/8" Dowels

TOOLS:

- · Saw
- Drill and 1/8" bit
- Double stick tape
- Elmer's carpenters glue
 50 and 100 Grit sandpaper
- Stain or paint and sealer

1" Scale Quilt Rack by Mark Stockton Reprinted from the 1997 Workproject Manual

- Cut ends from pattern, using two pieces of 1/8" wood fastened to-gether with double stick tape. Sand thoroughly while still taped together.
- 2. Drill five 1/8" holes as indicated on pattern while still taped together. Fine sand.



- Cut five lengths of 1/8" dowel -2-3/4" long. Glue into ends mak-ing sure ends of dowels are flush with outside of quilt rack.
- 4. Apply desired finish.
