Americana Shutter Planter Box

SUPPLIES NEEDED


- · Grandt Line Shutter #3541
- · 3/16th Northeastern Scale Lumber Channel Wood
- Marvy Uchida Punch (see photo)
- Lightweight card stock or red paper
- · Woodland Scenics Light Green
- · Coarse Turf
- 3/32 flower petals in your choice of colors


TOOLS NEEDED

- · Paint Brushes
- · Ruler
- Tweezers
- Scissors
- · Chopper II or mat knife
- · Smallest Stylus
- · Mouse pad
- Water/spray bottle
- · Wood glue
- · Thick Tacky Glue

PAINT

- · Ceramcoat Navy Blue
- · Tomato Spice
- White





- 1. Shaping Petals: With spray bottle, generously spray mousepad with water. Let water absorb slightly then sprinkle flower petals onto mousepad. Separate petals as necessary - petals will begin to absorb the water. While wet, begin deeply shaping petals with stylus. While shaping, if any petals stick to stylus – that's a good thing. Simply flick it off with your finger onto a dry surface and let dry. Continue shaping desired number of petals and let dry. (The water helps petals hold their shape when gluing to greenery.)
- Paint a small section of card stock, front and back, Tomato Spice. Let dry, then punch out stars with Marvy Uchida Punch.
- 3. Paint a small section of channel wood white.
- Paint upper section of shutter Navy Blue while still attached to form (sprue).
- When paint has dried, measure and trim shutter as desired. Touch up sides and bottom with Navy Blue.



- 6. Trim channel wood to width of shutter for planter box. Fill side openings in planter box with small snips from channel wood; you should now have a small box. Touch up edges with white paint. Let dry and glue to bottom of shutter.
- Glue tiny pieces of course turf inside planter box and trailing out of box.
- 8. Glue shaped petals to greenery.
- Glue stars to planter box and shutter where desired. For added dimension, glue a second or third star directly over first star, matching points. (If you used painted cardstock, carefully touch up edges of star.)

Optional: Reverse colors of planter box if desired.
