Bathrobe instructions

Use the pattern to cut out the bathrobe parts. There is one back piece (#1), two front pieces, (#2 & #3) two sleeves, (#4 & #5).



Clip the curves at the arm holes and fold over and glue a finished edge.



You may either glue or sew the side seams, I opted to glue. Glue or sew the front pieces to the back, taking care to keep right-side-up pieces facing correctly.



Hem the cuff end of the sleeve. Glue or the underarm seams of the sleeves so that it is a "tube".



Glue the sleeves into the arm holes and fold the front pieces over to close the bathrobe.

OBJ



The collar, the optional cuffs, and the belt are cut from doubled, stiffened, fabric. "Butter" a piece of fabric, about 6" x 3". (Spread a thin, even, coat of glue over the entire piece of fabric similar to buttering a slice of bread). Fold it over to make a piece about 1 1/2" x 6".



Cut a narrow strip, about 3/16"; the entire length to make the belt, cut the collar using the pattern, and cut two rectangles about 1/2" x 1 1/2" to make the cuffs.



Glue the collar in place over the top, trim away any untidy areas.



Glue the optional cuffs onto the sleeves, trim away the excess cuff and discard.

OBJ

Gently finger gather the bathrobe just slightly above the waist and wrap the belt. Glue the part that laps over and trim the ends neatly.



Drape the bathrobe fetchingly on the bed or over a chair.



Here are the templates. Size accordingly.
