# Bunny Slippers Kit

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SCALE: 1" LEVEL: NOVICE

#### **MATERIALS**

- •Two Pieces White Pipe Cleaner— 1-1/2" long
- •Two 3mm White Pom Pons
- •Two Pieces Finest Gauge Florist Wire—3/4" Long
- •Small Square of Heavy Weight Fusible Interfacing Approximately 2" x 2"
- Tacky Glue
- Paint—Pink and Black
- Parchment Scrap

#### **TOOLS**

- Scissors
- Fine-Pointed Paint Brush
- Iron

#### **ASSEMBLY**

#### To make ears:

Bend each of the 3/4" pieces of florist wire in half, forming a "V" shape.

Working on parchment, place fusible interfacing with shiny adhesive side up. Position florist wire "V"s on top of interfacing as per illustration.

3 Fold interfacing over and iron. Be sure to place a scrap of parchment between interfacing and iron. This will protect your iron from glue and your bunny ears from discoloration.

TIP: Keep "V" points a little way out of interfacing because this is how you will fasten ears onto slippers.

4 When interfacing is cool, using patterns, trace and cut out ears and slipper soles.

### To shape slippers:

I Find the halfway point of each of the 1 1/2" pieces of pipe cleaner. Shape toes by bending them around something small and round to form a "U", such as the tip of a glue bottle. Resist the temptation to just bend them in half because the slipper shape will be lost.

Pinch wire ends together at the rear.

 $3^{\hbox{Glue pom pons over wire ends.}}$  Let dry.

## Finishing details:

1 Using fine point of brush dipped in black paint, carefully and sparingly dot on two eyes. Using pink, dot on the nose. Paint a pink stripe down the center of each ear. Let dry.

2 Glue soles to slippers. Trim if necessary. Let dry.

 $3^{\text{Twist and bend ears to desired}} \\ \text{shape. Bend "V"s to fit flat into slipper soles. Saturate "V"s with glue and put in place. Let dry.}$
