

This project comes from the 1983 N-2 Sacramento Gold Rush Days.

Long Johns

SUPPLIES:

- Tacky Glue
- Fine Needle
- Matching Thread
- Matching Embroidery Thread
- Pattern
- Knit Fabric - red or tan ribbing
- (8) Beads for Buttons

1. Trace pattern on to paper and cut out. Pin pattern onto fabric. Cut out along solid lines. Cut neck opening out and down the center front opening. Cut along the drop seat lines.
2. Fold up a 1/4" hem on sleeves and legs. Glue.
3. Split embroidery thread into two threads. Starting at the bottom of the front slit, blanket stitch the entire front and neck opening. Sew buttons on now or you may glue them later.
4. Repeat for the drop seat opening. Sew buttons now or glue later.
5. Fold right sides together. With a 1/4" seam sew the side seams by hand.
 
6. Sew the crotch seam curving the point with a few rounded stitches. Clip almost to the stitching at the curve.
 
7. Turn right side out. Glue five buttons on left front neck area. Glue two buttons on each side of the drop seat area.
