
Projects from the Past



Using 1/16" balsa wood cut:

- (1) $7/8" \times 3/4"$ piece for the bottom (4) $1/4" \times 7/8"$ pieces for the sides
- (1) $1" \times 7/8"$ piece for the top

Glue two sides against the 7/8" length of the bottom piece keeping bottom edges flush.



Glue on remaining sides overlapping the first sides.



"For the Man in Your Life" A Box of Cigars By Kelly Fontanesi of Wee Thots Mini Club



Top View

Make two paper hinges (1/4"x7/8")from gold foil or decorating paper (cigar box labels, etc). Glue half to top and half to back of box (folding the paper lengthwise in half will help).



Add tiny pictures or pieces from cigar boxes, cigar rings, etc. and add paper or tape, such as labeling tape, to edges.

Cigars:

Mix up a brown clay the color of a cigar and roll into cigar shapes (same size as the box, less than 3/4"). Bake.



Paint a thin, shiny red band around cigar toward one end. When dry, paint a dab of bright gold paint over the red for a seal. Cigars can be left this way or wrapped individually in cellophane.
