Workbench

Every miniaturist needs a work place to create a favorite dollhouse treasure. This workbench even has a display shelf to show off the many Debbie Young dollhouses you've been building from previous issues. To check your measurements, our editor, Dorothy Hansen, has thrown in a tiny NAME ruler.

WOOD

- Top: $1/16" \times 2-1/2" \times 3-1/2"$
- Top supports:
cut 2: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 3-1/4"$
cut 2: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 2-1/8"$
- Legs:
cut 4: $1/4" \times 1/4" \times 2-3/4"$
- Lower supports:
cut 2: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 2-1/2"$
cut 2: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 1-5/8"$
- Back wall: $1/16" \times 1" \times 3-1/2"$
- Shelf: $1/16" \times 3/4" \times 3-1/2"$
- Shelf supports:
cut 2: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 5/8"$
cut 1: $1/8" \times 5/16" \times 3-1/2"$

TOOLS

Metal Miniatures

- Hammer #167
- Pliers #203
- Miter Box and Saw #393
- Screwdriver #527
- Glue Bottle #38
- Triangle #685E
- Rasp #794

WORKBENCH

1. Glue top supports as shown, using Tacky or wood glue.
2. Glue wood top on support rectangle, flush with the back of the support, and centered on the sides.
3. With the table upside down, glue a leg inside each of the corners of the top supports.
4. Glue lower supports between the legs $1-1/16"$ up from the bottom of each leg.
5. Glue the back wall on the back edge of the top.
6. Glue short shelf supports on either end of the back wall.
7. Glue long shelf support on top of the short supports.

8. Glue shelf on top of the long support.

TOOLS

Pliers and screwdriver:
paint handle red

Miter box and saw:
paint box and saw handle brown

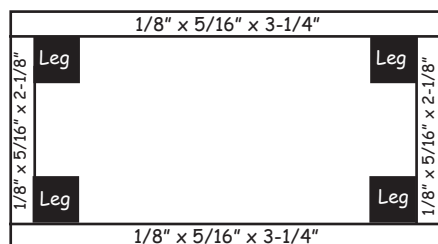
Triangle:
paint yellow

Ruler:
cut out paper ruler and glue on a piece of wood $1/32" \times 1/8" \times 1"$

Glue bottle:
paint bottle white, cap orange

Rasp:
paint handle brown
