

# WORK PROJECT: BUTTERFLIES, DRAGONFLIES,

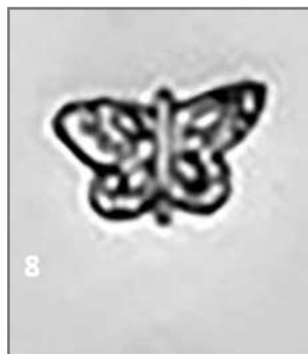
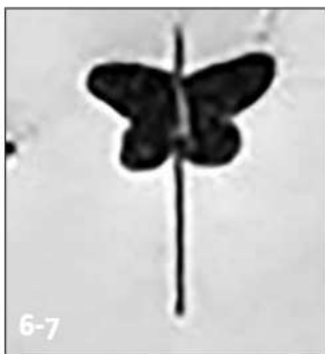
## Materials needed:

- White copy paper
- Scissors
- 24-gauge wire
- Tweezers/small pliers
- Acrylic paint (black, white, orange, yellow, green)
- Fine paint brush
- Tacky glue
- Super glue
- Cellophane from windowed envelope
- Magnifying lens



## Monarch Instructions:

- 1 Cut 1" strip of copy paper.
- 2 Fold in half.
- 3 Draw butterfly on fold.
- 4 Cut out butterfly.
- 5 Dip one butterfly-size spot of 2 inches of 24 gauge wire in tacky glue and then super glue. Attach wire on inside of butterfly along center of fold.
- 6 For butterfly color choices, Google images; a monarch is shown. TIP: paint whole butterfly black first.
- 7 After painting color pattern for butterfly species, let dry thoroughly.
- 8 Clip excess wire.



## Dragonfly Instructions:

- 1 Fold strip of clear cellophane from an envelope window.
- 2 Cut dragonfly double wings on fold.
- 3 Dip one wing-size spot of 2 inches of 24-gauge wire in super glue and attach wire on inside of wing fold.
- 4 For dragonfly species color choices, Google images.
- 5 Clip excess wire.
