

## ROURD TABLE DEMONSTRATION

## MATERIALS FOR SUNGLASSES

Paint Brush
A Photocopy of the Patterns below
Glue
Index Card
Sharp Scissors
No. 11 Exacto Knife with a new blade
A piece of the scrap film you get back when you get color
print film developed, that has a darkened (exposed) section
(the leader, or tail end).
A straight pin
Tube of Acrylic Paint, color of your choice

Glue the photo copy of the glasses pattern to the index card. Cut out around the outside line with the scissors or Exacto knife. Cut out eye holes with Exacto knife. Paint all over with the acrylic paint. Cut out stencil of lens piece to match the glasses you selected. Lay the stencil over the dull side of the film negative. The film may have several shades of color on it so pick the one that goes best with your paint color. Using your Exacto knife or straight pin, scratch in the outline of the stencil in two places to make two lenses. Cut out the lenses and check for fit with the frames. Apply glue to the back rim of the frame and set lenses on it, adjusting as necessary for proper fit. Fold the ear pieces back, and head for the beach!
