

1" scale - Decorate a Bunny Cupcake

SUPPLIES

- Cupcake blank (or make a cupcake with fimo)
- Frosting: white, light pink, pink (or use thick paint)
- 2 light blue no hole beads (for eyes)
- Sculpey: pink
- Fimo: white
- Plate for your finished cupcake

TOOLS

- Double back removable tape
- Dental pick
- Syringe (for frosting or paint)

Making the ears

Take some pink Sculpey and shape into a middle bunny ear shape. Then by rolling out some white Fimo Soft (I like the white in Fimo brand much better than Sculpey white. It's brighter) roll out a thin strip in your craft pasta roller. About a third of the width of your pink center. Wrap around the pink center and trim so it's an even ear shape. You've now made a bunny ear cane! Then by gently working it and pulling at the same time try and keep the ear shape and make it longer. The longer it gets the smaller it gets. Make it as small as you need for the

bunny ears. You may have to cut it into sections to keep it manageable. Then bake a cane strip when you get the desired ear width at 225 degrees for 15 minutes. Let cool for about 10 seconds and start to slice the cane. You now have bunny ears!

1. Take your cupcake blank and place it on double sided sticky removable tape. Using the frosting star tip start on the edge and work your way around making tiny stars.



2. When you've gone completely around the edge fill in the center.



3. Using your tweezers put the bunny ears in place.

4. Now using the pick tool from the Cupcake Mold Kit lick the tip of it and pick up the baby



blue eyes and place them the bunny cupcake.

5. Next take some dark pink frosting (mix using a tiny bit of red paint and the white frosting) and draw in the nose. After it's drawn then fill it in completely.



6. Finally you can make the little smiley face.



7. Using a lighter pink make 3 whiskers for each side of the face by just drawing a line.



8. Your all done! Hope you had fun!!
