5'mores

As'more is a traditional nighttime campfire treat consisting of a roasted marshmallow and a layer of chocolate sandwiched between two pieces of graham cracker.

If you were ever a Girl Scout you will remember finding the perfect stick to

put that marshmallow on and roasting it over the campfire. While the origin of the dessert is unclear, the first recorded version of the recipe



can be found in the publication "Tramping and Trailing with the Girl Scouts" from 1927. The recipe is credited to Loretta Scott Crew, who reportedly made them by the campfire for the Girl Scouts. Although it is unknown when the name was shortened, recipes for "Some Mores" are in various Girl Scout publications until at least 1971.

When making miniatures it is always good to do some research. Go to the store and buy some graham crackers, marshmallows and chocolate bars and make your real life size S'mores too.

· Supplies ·

- Sahara Beige Fimo (Graham crackers)
- Brown Fimo (Chocolate Bar)
- White Fimo (Marshmallows)
- Liquid Scupley (melted marshmallows)
- Peppercorn or Velcro (sold in small dots)
- Small Brush or Q-Tip
- Chalk: mustard and brown
- Acrylic gloss sealer



Graham Crackers

Roll Fimo out 1/16'' thick $\times 3/16'' \times 3/8''$ for whole gram cracker.

There are four section to one whole gram cracker with dots within them)
Texture the top using a peppercorn or Velcro and use a common pin for dots -

Making the S'more may need to make a little bigger than 1/2 of a whole cracker

Bake according to instruction on package.

Using a brush or Q-tip, add some mustard colored chalk and then a bit of brown.

Let dry.

Seal with gloss sealer.



· Chocolate Bar ·

Roll out Fimo $1/16'' \times 1/8'' \times 7/16''$ and mark section with thin blade (12 for whole bar)

Lightly texture with peppercorn (not necessary to texture if you are making a S'more)

Bake.




Marshmallows

Roll out a snake of white fimo.

Slice and make $1/8" \times 1/8"$ marshmallow flatten top and bottom. Try to get them uniform.

Bake.



Melted Marshmallow

Add liquid Sculpey to white Fimo part of S'more assembly
