
ROUNDTABLES

Tea Time Tray • 1" scale by Katie and Sue Ann Ketchum, Damascus, Maryland

Materials/Supplies

- Base: 1/16" x 1" x 17/16"basswood
- CLA70225 or HW7078 Scallop Trim or 1/16" x 1/4" plain basswood, 2 pieces 1-7/16" and 2 pieces 7/8"
- MinWax Early American stain marker
- 1/4 of a mini doily or a small plate
- · Model Magic air-dry white clay
- · Apple Barrel Paint Toffee and Golden Brown
- · Tulip Puff Paint
- Paper Napkin
- · Chrysnbon Cup and Saucer
- · Gallery Glass Chestnut Brown or Amber Glass Stain
- · Small Bead for Vase
- · Dried Flowers




Tray

Stain wood pieces before assembly. Glue short strips between longer strips. Glue this assembly to top of base.



Vase of Flowers

Glue flowers into bead vase and glue it to position "A" on tray.



Napkin

Cut a 3/4" square from 1 layer of paper

Fold square in half to make triangle.

From the fold, turn up 1/8" and flatten the new fold.

Turn napkin over and roll it from one end to the other.

Stand napkin upright and tuck the remaining end into the fold.

Glue napkin to position "B" on tray.



Tea Cup

Glue cup to saucer and then glue it to position "C" on the tray.

Add a drop or two of glass stain inside



Pastry

Roll a small ball of clay 3/16" in diameter.



Flatten the ball, then roll the flat disk around the tip of a toothpick to make a cone shape.

When the clay is dry, paint it with a mix of 1 drop of each paint color and 2 drops of water.

When dry, remove cone from toothpick; pipe a dollop of Puff Paint into the open end.

Glue pastry to doily or plate in position "D" on the tray.
