WORK PROJECT

Quick Quilts

Materials:

scissors

iron

Method A:

14 yard of small quilt square pattern material contrasting material for back light pajama flannel for batting


OR

Method B:

6½ x 6½" background material 25 ¾ x ¾" squares of tiny prints in harmonizing colors light pajama flannel for batting Stitch Witchery

- Cut a 6½ x 6½" square of quilt print or a size that looks like a whole quilt top.
- 2. Cut pajama flannel same size and put on wrong side of quilt
- Cut backing fabric same size. Put backing fabric on quilt print, RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (See Fig. 1), and sew around 3 sides. (Fig. 2).
- 4. Clip corners and turn right side out. Turn under 4th edge and slip stitch closed. Hand or machine quilt on quilt design.

- Arange 25 ¾" squares in pleasing pattern. Place arrangement on Stitch Witchery and then place both on background fabric. Iron according to Stitch Witchery directions. (Be careful the squares don't get moved before you iron.)
- Continue from #2 above. Use buttonhole or machine zigzag stitch to cover all raw edges from the 25 squares. This will be your quilting.



pajama fannel quilt print Figure 1 right side right side backing fabric


