MAKING MINI SHRUBBERY

These began with a 1" Styrofoam ball (the crunchy kind of foam). You can use any size or shape and trim it to what you want.

- 1. The original ball.
- 2. Flatten the bottom and use your sharp knife to carve the foam into the shape you want. Squeeze those stubborn spots a bit.
- 3. Stick a toothpick into the bottom as a handle and daub your "shrub" with green paint. Let dry.
- Actually, it looks good at Step 3! But you can cover your shrub with fine greenery for a more realistic finish. It helps to thin the glue just a bit before applying the greenery. Press the greenery in place and let dry. Tap off any loose greenery and plant your shrub.
